1. Create an HTML file containing 2 forms, a Simple Form, and an Intermediate Form, as shown below. Make sure left column of the Simple Form is left aligned and the right column of the Simple Form is right aligned, as shown.

Submit Intermediate

2. Create submitSimple() JavaScript function that executes when user clicks "Submit Simple" button, and updates the Simple Form. The Tax Amount and Total Amount fields must be correct based on the values entered by user into the Price and Tax Percent fields.

3. Create submitIntermediate() function, that executes when user clicks "Submit Intermediate" button, and updates the Intermediate Form. The Tax Amount fields, Subtotal fields and Grand Total field must be correct based on the values entered by user into the Price and Tax Percent fields.

4. (Extra credit on test, but not on this practice test) Create an Advanced Form and submitAdvanced() function which is the same as its Intermediate counterparts except they allow the user to add additional rows to the entry form.
